

<p><u>Warm up:</u> <u>exquisite</u> <u>corpse</u></p>	<p>We sit in a circle or semi-circle. At the ends of this semicircle (or at a certain point in the circle) I give them two pieces of paper: one will go right, one will go left. I have prepared the opening lines of two different stories. The children have to write two sentences and fold the paper so that the last sentence is the only one that can be read. They pass it to the person on the right or the left, depending which paper they receive. The next person will add two lines, but then only show one. There will be a lot of guessing involved, so the result should be fun!</p>
<p><u>Still life</u></p>	<p>We pick up a postcard with a painting and write a few lines about what we can see.</p>
