We need Characters (who) A setting (where and when) A problem (what) That finds a way to get sorted out.</p> <p>To represent this, three children come to the front and represent 3 obstacles. I present a scenario (I want to buy some ice cream) and they try to stop me from getting to my goal.</p>
<p><b><u>Writing from photos</u></b></p>	<p>I place a few photos on the table and ask them to pick a picture they like. They hold it up and talk about the photo, describe it and say what they think is happening in the picture.</p> <p>There is no right or wrong answer, it's all about using our imagination.</p>
