

<p><u>Warm up</u></p>	<p>What has everyone written during the holidays?</p> <p>Do they remember what we covered last time? Parts of a story a story and writing from photographs.</p>
<p><u>News</u></p>	<p>Today we will experiment with a new format: news articles. These can be fiction or nonfiction for the purposes of this class, for our newspaper, <i>News for a Change</i>. We discuss what newspapers typically consider “news” and if they agree with this, or not.
