

Warm up	What has everyone written during the holidays? Do they remember what we covered last time? Parts of a story a story and writing from photographs.
News	Today we will experiment with a new format: news articles. These can be fiction or nonfiction for the purposes of this class, for our newspaper, <i>News for a Change</i> . We discuss what newspapers typically consider "news" and if they agree with this, or not. If they had their own newspaper, what would it include?
