

Biography	Hand out paper for them to write a short <b>bio</b> and complete the sentences: Art is Writing is This will go on our book.
<u>Teamwork</u>	Today they will create a story in groups of two or three. Sometimes when we get stuck, someone else's ideas may help us move on. We practice listening to each other, learning from each other, compromising.  Each team chooses one painting as inspiration. They answer the first questions together
Writing	I have chosen a few paintings. They pick one and complete the information on the worksheet. This will help them write the stories that will be part of the book. We will use these worksheets over the next few weeks.  Instructions: Write down the title of the painting and the name of the artist. Then, think of your own title for the painting. Write a few adjectives that describe the painting. Now pick one item or feature in the painting. What can you say about it?  Put yourself inside the painting. Are you one of the people, animals or items painted? Are you watching what is happening?  Immerse yourself in the painting or focus on one item or feature. Write a story inspired by this painting. Challenge yourself and have fun!
